## Why the awards?

The awards are an opportunity to recognise healthcare professionals for their work in furthering nutrition in the African continent.

## Who can be nominated?

Healthcare professionals including dietitians, medical practitioners, nutritionists, nurses and pharmacists.

## How does the nomination process work?

The nominator must complete the awards form on [www.nnia.org](http://www.nnia.org). The healthcare professional can be nominated in one of the following categories:

**Emerging Scientist Award:** Healthcare professionals under the age of 40 who have recently completed research towards their Masters or Doctoral studies. The focus of their research should be in one of the following focus areas:

- Maternal / foetal / infant nutrition in the first 1 000 days
- Nutrition and infectious diseases
- Nutrition in the life cycle
- Socio-environmental determinants of nutrition and eating behaviour
- Food and nutrition security

This individual should have been published in at least two peer-reviewed journals and given one oral presentation at a reputable conference / congress.

## Nutrition in Communities:

Recognition for the initiation and facilitation of nutrition programmes for households / schools / special projects. The programme showcases innovation, community participation, stakeholder engagement and support, measurable impact and sustainability. A paper on this programme published in a peer-reviewed journal may be submitted for this category.

## Nutrition in Paediatrics:

Recognition for work done to improve the lives of children from the first 1 000 days of life to the age of 12 years through nutritional intervention. The work should showcase innovation and measurable impact, with the nominee going beyond the normal call of duty. A paper published in a peer-reviewed journal detailing this intervention may be submitted for this category.

## Clinical Nutrition:

Recognition for work done to improve the lives of individuals of any age group through nutritional intervention in the clinical setting from primary (clinics) to tertiary (teaching hospital) levels. The work should showcase innovation and measurable impact, with the nominee going beyond the normal call of duty. A paper published in a peer-reviewed journal detailing this intervention may be submitted for this category.
